Classes

HomeLink classes will be held on Tuesdays and will be assigned a time block per family

Monthly Reviews

Review meetings will be held at the end of the month and students are required to be present at the meeting.

The end of the month review will be the same as last year where students will bring in all work from the month to submit or make copies of.

Also, this year, students will be keeping a portfolio to track progress on paper as well as bringing in one item from one of the core areas to submit for progress each week.

Testing

Students will Star360 test in September, January, and April as well as the Smarter Balance testing in May. Students that are in 5th and 8th grade will complete the MSP Science test as well. Testing will be held during Tuesday class times.

Showcases

Students will have 3 Evening showcases that will take place in the classroom/gym. The dates are: Monday, December 10th 6:30-7:30 pm
Monday, March 18th 6:30-7:30 pm
Monday, May 20th 6:30-7:30 pm

The first and second showcases will be presented by students on work/skills that we have been working on in class.

In the third showcase, students will be presenting something that they have been working on at home. Students will need to submit an idea of what they will present by Spring Break (specific details will be presented as we get closer to that time).

Field Trips

HomeLink will participate in 2-3 field trips over the school year, as well as several of the Capitol Theatre performances. Dates, times, and places will be announced during the school year. Reminder: Field trips and Capitol Theatre performances do require parent participation and transportation to and from.

Central Washington Reading Round Up

Reading Round Up packets will go home on our first week of school. This is a program that encourages K-5th grade reading 300 minutes outside of school work. Students keep track of minutes and titles of books read on a worksheet. Worksheets need to be turned into HomeLink on Tuesday, September 18th in order to qualify for a discounted ticket into the Fairgrounds.
